Youth Mission Corp: YMC is a Missions Program aimed towards high school age students (going into 9 -12 grades in the fall) in which they raise support to be involved in the ministry of CBC. They will work in several different areas including: counselor in training, kitchen, maintenance & grounds, housekeeping, adventure program, office, and store/canteen. The YMC commitment is a minimum of 5 weeks: 1 week of training and 4 weeks of service. Each YMC will experience the counselor in training position. The remaining positions will be assigned as needed. Each week they will have a different position in order to gain experience in many areas.

Support: A YMC not wishing to be paid must raise \$400 (for 1 week of training and 4 weeks of camp.) To get paid each week, a YMC must raise a minimum of \$600 (for 4 weeks salary at \$50 per week.)

Qualifications to serve at CBC:

- Christian whose personal life demonstrates that you are walking with the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Desire to communicate your personal faith to youth and adults.
- Have an emotional and spiritual maturity which is readily seen.
- Have a love for children and young people.
- Able to work together as a team.
- Exhibit a desire to learn.
- Demonstrate Christian character.
- Desire to serve others.
- Agree with the Statement of Faith of the Evangelical Free Church of America.

Descriptions of areas a YMC may work in:

Counselor in Training - Assist a senior counselor with day and night responsibilities for a group of campers assigned to the cabin. Help plan and lead Bible studies, assist at skills class and adventure program, and help lead one-on-one discipleship time with each camper. Are responsible for the campers in the cabin under the senior counselor's direction.

Kitchen - Work with the head and assistant cook to prepare the dining hall for meals, serving of the meals, and clean up after each meal including putting food away, doing dishes, and removing trash.

Maintenance & Grounds - Help maintain the buildings, grounds, machinery, etc. Work to maintain overall appearance and cleanliness of the camp. Assist housekeeping as needed.

Housekeeping - Perform daily cleaning and other cleaning projects, stock supplies, do laundry, check all areas periodically during the day, and oversee other staff members who are assigned to help.

Adventure Program - Assist the adventure program coordinator in accomplishing their responsibilities.

Office work - Work with the summer office manager and help with any paperwork, filing, typing, and registration process. Help process mail and distribute to campers.

Store/canteen - Work with the summer store manager and help with the daily functions of the camp store and canteen. Help stock shelves as needed.
