### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Have a relationship with Jesus Christ and a passion for sharing the gospel of Christ.
- Have experience working with kids/youth.
- Able to work and be active outdoors in the heat for long periods of time.
- Ability to lead games, Bible studies, and other activities.
- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Must have a reliable form of transportation.

### **General Responsibility:**

To support Cooperstown Bible Camp's mission and purpose of connecting campers to Christ. The counselor is responsible for the direct care of 6-12 campers each day by providing the behavior of a positive Christian role model, an environment that is loving, and caring for them spiritually, mentally, and physically. When not assigned to campers, you will be repositioned in other areas of need at Cooperstown Bible Camp such as housekeeping, maintenance, and kitchen help.

### **Specific Responsibilities:**

1. To welcome campers and families at the beginning of each week.
2. To work alongside all other staff living in Christian Community that creates lasting relationships.
3. Leading activities and Bible studies with intent of sharing biblical principles or spiritual tools.
4. Having high energy, a loving kindness, and patience at all times with campers.
5. Disciplining behaviors with love and consistency.
6. Providing an environment for campers to ask questions and grow deeper in their faith.
7. Follow all CBC standards, and agree with the EFCA statement of faith.
8. Represent the camp and its purpose in a positive manner when you are in public.
9. Possess an attitude and actions which continually reflect that Christ lives in you.

- Ability and willingness to work long hours.
- Be a team player.
- Ability to stay focused and work nontraditional hours to make certain the job is well done.
- Create a welcoming and open environment for campers, guests, and other staff members.

- Mentor or disciple other staff members.



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
