Minimum Qualifications:

- Basic understanding of food prep and sanitation.
- Willingness to spend time with campers and other guests.

General Responsibility:

To support Cooperstown Bible Camp's mission and purpose of Making Jesus Known. The Kitchen Crew will work alongside the Head Cook in preparing all meals, serving food, and assisting in cleaning after meals.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. To work alongside all other staff living in Christian Community to create lasting relationships.
2. Have high energy, kindness, and patience always with campers.
3. Follow all CBC standards and agree with the EFCA statement of faith.
4. Represent the camp and its purpose in a positive manner when you are in public.
5. Possess an attitude and actions which continually reflect that Christ lives in you.
6. Work at constantly improving the quality of food at Cooperstown Bible Camp.
7. To meet and maintain all sanitary procedures when cleaning and cooking.
8. Assist counselors by being a "Cabin Buddy".
9. Assist Head Cook in food prep.
10. Obey all kitchen guidelines for safety.
11. Ability to work in all other areas of camp if needed. (TTO)

- Ability to stay focused and work nontraditional hours to make certain the job is well done.
- Create a welcoming and open environment for all campers, guests, and other staff members.
- Ability to work independently when needed and be a team player.
