

Buildings & Grounds report for 2025

2025 has been an extremely busy year for the buildings and grounds committee. In January, after much deliberation, prayer and planning, the final decision to remove the Tabernacle was made. The decision to retire the Tab was announced at the annual meeting. A decommissioning service was held in March, and the actual demolition took place May 8, 2025.

In the spring of 2025, the subject of the condition of the director's residence kept coming to the surface. A detailed examination of the home revealed that there is an urgent need to replace the home due to unhealthy conditions of the structure from years of flooding. Much discussion took place and the board made the decision to replace the home. We have thoroughly researched the options available to us. Please stay tuned for more information as it comes along.
