**Minimum Qualifications:**

- Must have good communication skills
- Knowledgeable of basic concepts, practices, and procedures in audio mixing and video production

**General Responsibility:**

To support Cooperstown Bible Camp's mission and purpose to Make Jesus Known. The Tech and Sound team will set up and break down for all worship practices and chapel services ranging from operating sound board, monitoring feedback, setting up microphones, timing out videos and slides, controlling lights and more.

**Specific Responsibilities:**

1. To work alongside all other staff living in Christian Community to create lasting relationships.
2. Have high energy, kindness, and patience always with campers.
3. Follow all CBC standards and agree with the EFCA statement of faith.
4. Represent the camp and its purpose in a positive manner when you are in public.
5. Possess an attitude and actions which continually reflect Christ lives in you.
6. Able to think and react quickly under pressure and present problem-solving skills.
7. Available and prepared before all sound checks, practices, and services.
8. Ensure stage is set up – lighting, microphones, channels, lines... etc.
9. Manage chapel visual presentations – game graphics, videos, and song and speaker slides.
10. Ensure the quality and care of CBC chapel service equipment – cleaning and storing.
11. Available to help in other areas of camp if needed (TTO).

**Essential Functions:**

- Have a relationship with Jesus Christ and a passion to grow in that relationship.
- Ability to stay focused and work nontraditional hours to make certain the job is well done.
- Be self-motivated and desired to improve quality of chapel service.
- Create a welcoming and open environment for all campers, guests, and other staff members.
- Ability to work independently when needed and be a team player.
- Be eager to learn new things.
