Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have a reliable form of transportation. (If under the age of 18 exceptions can be made)
- Willingness to spend time with campers and other guests.

General Responsibility:

To support Cooperstown Bible Camp's mission and purpose of connecting campers to Christ. The Kitchen Crew will work alongside the Head Cook in preparing all meals, serving food, and assisting in cleaning after meals.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. To work alongside all other staff living in Christian Community to create lasting relationships.
2. To meet and maintain all sanitary procedures when cleaning and cooking.
3. Have high energy, kindness, and patience always with campers.
4. Work at constantly improving the quality of food at Cooperstown Bible Camp.
5. Follow all CBC standards, and agree with the EFCA statement of faith.
6. Represent the camp and its purpose in a positive manner when you are in public.
7. Possess an attitude and actions which continually reflect that Christ lives in you.
8. Assist counselors by being a "Cabin Buddy".
9. Help in other areas if needed.
10. Assist Head Cook in food prep.
11. Obey all kitchen guidelines for safety.

Essential Functions:

- Have a relationship with Jesus Christ and a passion to grow in that relationship.
- Ability to stay focused and be self-motivated.
- Create a welcoming and open environment for all campers, guests, and other staff members.
- Ability to work independently when needed and be a team player.
- Be flexible: the ability works nontraditional hours to make certain the job is well done.
- Look for ways to impact camper's lives.
- View yourself, and other kitchen workers as a servant ministry.
- Be eager to learn.
