2. Have high energy, kindness, and patience always with campers.
3. Follow all CBC standards and agree with the EFCA statement of faith.
4. Represent the camp and its purpose in a positive manner when you are in public.

6. To meet, maintain and assist in all cleaning, stocking, and organizing requirements daily.
7. Work at constantly improving camper store and camp experience.
8. Assist counselors by being a "Cabin Buddy".
9. Assist Store Manager in store inventory.
10. Obey all barista guidelines in grinding, blending, brewing, frothing, and serving espresso drinks.
11. Ensure the quality and care of store machinery and equipment.
12. Ability to work in all other areas of camp if needed. (TTO)
