Minimum Qualifications:

- Have a relationship with Jesus Christ and a passion for sharing the gospel of Christ.
- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Must be at least one year out of High school.
- Have basic experience working with maintenance equipment, or a willingness to learn.
- Able to work and be active outdoors in the heat for long periods of time.
- Must be willing to serve the camp in areas outside of role when needed.
- Must have a reliable form of transportation.

General Responsibility:

To support Cooperstown Bible Camp's mission and purpose of Making Jesus Known. The Adventure Program staff is indirectly responsible for up to 20 campers or more that are engaged in activities. Their focus is primarily on assisting the Program Director in operating all program related activities that go on at Cooperstown Bible Camp.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. To work alongside all other staff living in Christian Community to create lasting relationships.
2. Have high energy, kindness, and patience always with campers.
3. Follow all CBC standards and agree with the EFCA statement of faith.
4. Represent the camp and its purpose in a positive manner when you are in public.
5. Possess an attitude and actions which continually reflect that Christ lives in you.
6. Lead activities with intent of sharing biblical principles or spiritual tools.
7. Disciplining behaviors when safety is compromised.
8. Responsible for set up and take down of all camp activities.
9. Maintain and operate all Adventure Program related activities.
10. Follow all standards set forth by the Camp Directors.
11. Ability to work in all other areas of camp if needed. (TTO)

Essential Functions:

- Have a relationship with Jesus Christ and a passion to grow in that relationship.
- Ability to stay focused and work nontraditional hours to make certain the job is well done.
- Create a welcoming and open environment for all campers, guests, and other staff members.
- Ability to work independently when needed and be a team player.
- Be High Ropes certified. (Required training occurs during staff training.)
- Knows basics for safety and operations of riflery and archery.
- Eager to learn new things.
